NEW YORK – “LÁTIGO”, as the highly acclaimed *Quartet San Francisco's* second full-length album, has been nominated for two Grammy awards as announced by The Recording Academy. Fronted by nationally renowned violinist Jeremy Cohen, *Quartet San Francisco* incorporates a more modern approach as they swing and groove in many genres, and with “LÁTIGO,” the group features wall-to-wall tangos and Latin-inflected compositions and mood pieces. Multimedia company elfenworks LLC, headed by Creative Director Lauren Speeth, is the executive producer of “LÁTIGO.”

“I’m thrilled to be involved with this project,” says Speeth. “Jeremy Cohen and Quartet San Francisco are phenomenal musicians who played their hearts out on this CD. I hope this outstanding honor brings word of their tremendous talent to an even wider audience.”

As a whole, 2007 has proven to be a successful year for elfenworks, with legendary violinist Aaron Rosand’s 2-disc set, “AARON ROSAND IN NORWAY” winning the JPF (Just Plain Folks) Music Award for Best Classical Concerto Album. JPF Awards are the largest and most diverse music awards of any kind in the world, with multiple elfenworks artists earning placements and recognition.

Tammy Hall, the premier piano jazz artist on the elfenworks label and whose music is partnered with The Elfenworks Foundation, made the short list for the 2007 Grammy® nomination (*Best New Artist; Best Jazz Instrumental Album; Best Jazz Instrumental Solo; Best Long Form Music Video; Best Short Form Music Video*) for her *Blue Divine* album and corresponding *Reflections* DVD. Her follow-up release “Rejuve” gives back to her listeners and is a ‘healing’ CD, composed of original tracks that Hall and producer Lauren Speeth developed solely with listeners in mind. The CD features Hall on piano and Speeth on violin, along with Michaëlle Goerlitz on percussion. Hall and The Elfenworks Foundation have extended their partnership to the Greater Bay Area Chapter of the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society, and will distribute “REJUVE” to those affected by these diseases.
